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Russian палец vs. Czech prst – on comparative study of linguistic world view for closely related languages

The report is an integral part of the larger research devoted to comparison of the Czech vs. Russian linguistic world view as related to particular human body part, i.e. arm/hand.

The report will consider constructions as per the model [*adjektivum*] + *палец/prst* (*длинные, костлявые, тонкие, нежные пальцы / dlouhé, tenké, štíhlé, kladívkové prsty*). National language stereotypes will be determined that link this body part with peculiarities of person and his or her character.

The study is based on texts of fiction literature written in the 19th and 20th century in the corresponding languages.
